MINUTES

September 28, 2009

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Westampton Township Environmental Advisory Committee (EAC) was held at the Municipal Building on Rancocas Road. At 7:30, the meeting was called to order by Chairperson Dena Moore. An opening statement was read that this meeting was advertised in the Burlington County Times and posted in the Municipal Building.
